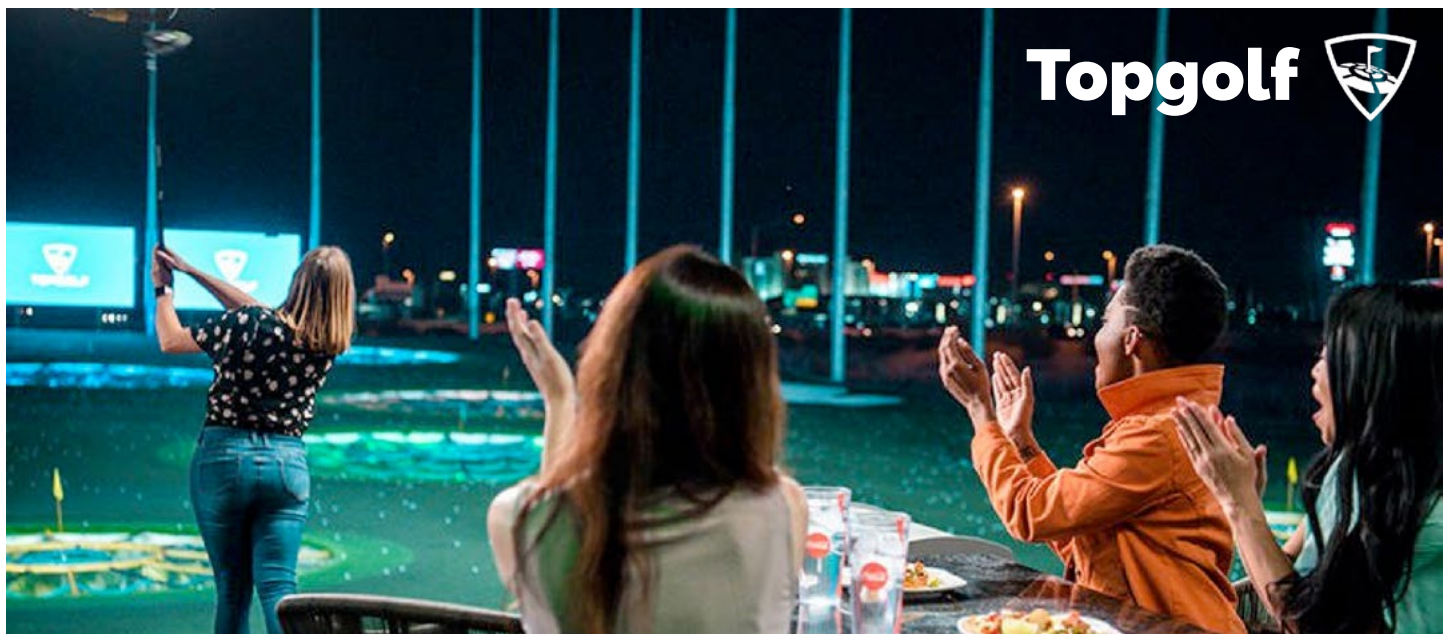
Please note if you are having issues accessing the My sideline system on your school network please try on a non-school network (phone etc) as some school networks seem to have a security feature which is restricting site access.

UPDATED GCTAS FIELD MAP

The playing precinct has increased in size and now boasts 30 touch fields for use, although it is unlikely that all will be in operation at once.

The proposed site map above will give you a rough idea of the proposed venue layout. Extra information including tent sites, toilets, parking, catering, will be added and be made available later.

EVENT BRIEFING

This year the Tournament Director (Peter Bell) will conduct a pre event briefing which you may access on the Gold Coast Titans All Schools website.

This will be available from Monday 12 September 2022. This briefing will allow all school contacts to check event specific information relevant to their planning and organization.

It will also serve to ensure you are ready to go – with many of your questions answered – hopefully!!

It is critical that you have a look at the presentation especially if you are new to All Schools.

TENTS & SHADE STRUCTURES

We will be organising the allocation of sites for all Tents and similar shade structures.

Schools will need to apply for this (same as 2021) and will then be allocated a number which will correspond to the site area to place your tent.

There shall be strictly no placement of tents without approval please. Many schools

have submitted their request for a site – many have not!

You have until Friday 9 September to request a place for your tent. After this time there will be no further requests taken.

(Note – we spent hours of extra time having to find places for people who are not organized and can't do things in the required time frame.)

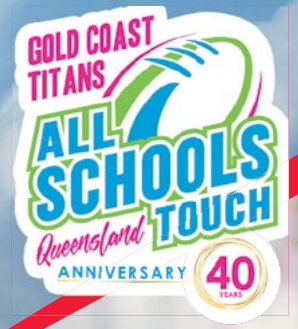

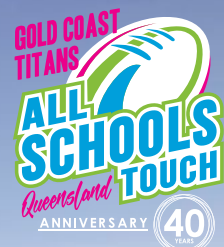
