ALL SCHOOLS PRELIMINARY GAMES

Just confirming that in order to provide maximum opportunities at the event we have had to cover as many games as is possible to lighten the load.

There are two ways you can help – one is to register for your local Regional All Schools. These are usually conducted in your local touch community region (see below) Many of you already play in these events as a lead in and for practice before the Queensland All Schools.

If you do not play in any of these and it is not possible for you to commit, then you may be required to play one off games at your school or at the school of your competitor.

When I construct the draw I will usually pair up some close schools in the same Pool which can then be used as an All Schools fixture.

The home team may have the advantage, but they also have to organize an independent referee.

These Preliminary games enable us to invite more schools and therefore we hope that you can play your part. If you have major issues with a scheduled Preliminary Game you may have to reconsider your nomination

and allow for someone to take your place.

Remember it is strict condition of entry to be able to meet draw obligations. Please discuss with me any concerns.

LEVY PAYMENT

For all the first time schools, please be aware of the levy payment deadline.

It is strictly end of Queensland Schools term one or the COB Friday 31 March 2023. You shall soon begin to receive invoices direct to your school email for forwarding to the relevant finance person at your school.

Please action immediately as we often have issues with the invoice sitting in a tray somewhere. Failure to pay the levy on time will, in the first instance, receive a friendly reminder before your teams are replaced by one of the many desperate reserve schools.

REFEREES

As most of you would be aware the requirement of providing one student referee per school is now mandatory.

Thank you in advance for committing to this initiative in your school. I am confident that you will benefit long term for ensuring the development of student referees as part of your on-going touch program.

For newer schools all our referees are paid (see Referee Policy) and they are also required to do a minimum of 10 games at the All Schools.

They must wear either the QAS official referee uniform or the pink TFA referee shirt. No other shirts are allowed. Inferno can assist with referee uniforms.

Another task you need to complete is to provide to us your student referee names by the end of term 1 (April 1) the same day as payments are due.

Registration of your referees will take place throughout term 2 and 3 and or as they come and go. More about this in later newsletters.

NON REGISTERED TEACHERS/STAFF

Please be aware that we have tightened guidelines around the use of persons who are not registered teachers or on staff at your schools.

Previously there have been a few parents and other community persons fulfilling tasks with your teams.

We are happy for this to continue (you need all the help you can get!) however, given some issues we have had with some non teacher coaches and parents in particular, the following rules (see Conditions of Play 2023 note 5.4) shall apply in 2023 –

During games teams may have up to 14 players in the sub box in playing attire plus up to 3 coach/managers or 17 persons in total.

No other individuals may be in the box area at any time during the

game. Parents are not permitted in the sub box area at any time during games unless they are registered as staff.

Schools that have appointed Parents or non-teaching persons must ensure that they are firstly under the direction/supervision of the registered teacher responsible for the school's teams during all games at the event and secondly, that they understand that they are also under the direction of the Tournament Director.

Please reinforce the codes of conduct with all your staff. Poor and unsportsmanlike behaviour by students is a direct result of the example set by the Coach.

We do not want to have to suspend a team for this and hope you can assist us to maintain the same standards expected in a classroom or at your school.
