### **COVIDSAFE REQUIREMENTS**

Queensland Touch Football and the Queensland All Schools are dedicated to providing a safe environment for all players and spectators. The event complies with a Queensland Government approved Industry COVID Safe Plan – Field Sports and will have COVIDSafe preventative measures in place throughout the event.

Queensland Touch Football (QTF) are working closely with the Brisbane City Council and local public health authorities to ensure the Queensland All Schools (QAS) is delivered in accordance with all COVID measures and provides a safe and enjoyable experience for all attendees.

The following key principles will be implemented

- QTF will implement best practice arrangements before, during and post the event base on advice from Government and Health Authorities.
- QTF will ensure participants, spectators and officials maintain and monitor physical distancing of 1.5m off the field of play.
- QTF will enhance public hygiene measures before, during and after the event.

We all need to play our part in protecting ourselves from COVID-19. Teachers will be responsible for ensuring their players/students/staff/referees abide by all COVID safe measures implemented at the QAS.

### NO ONE SHOULD ATTEND IF THEY HAVE:

- COVID-19 or has been in direct contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- Flu-like symptoms or who is a high health risk (e.g. due to age or pre-existing conditions.)
- Travelled internationally or to a COVID declared hotspot.

### **PARTICIPANTS TRACING**

All Participants, Referees, Coaches, School Contacts will be required to check in every time they attend the QLD All Schools venue. This will be done via a QR code which will be provided around the venue and positioned within each school tent.

The QR codes are also located at the back of this document which may make it easier for everyone to check in and out each day. **You must scan the code on the same day you attend the venue.** The app will automatically assign you against todays date.

The QAS encourage all attendees to download the Australian Government COVID Safe App and leave it on while at the venue.

### **SPECTATORS**

Unfortunately, due to the current COVID-19 environment, no spectators will be allowed to attend the event. Parents may drop off, pick up their child and carry out any activity deemed necessary to ensure their safety (i.e. waiting with them until a teacher arrives at the venue etc). However, Parents who linger to watch games will be asked to move on.

### **SCHOOL TENTS**

All School contacts are required to complete the tent allocation form which was sent out and provide this to Peter Bell by the 24<sup>th</sup> of September. If you have not requested a tent size you will not be permitted to erect a tent on site.

Due to current COVID-19 restrictions QTF are working closely with the Brisbane City Council and the Public Health Unit to manage the COVID restrictions appropriately (i.e. social distancing requirements), whilst still providing shade and shelter to teams.

Therefore, there will be maximum numbers allowed under each tent, there is to be no co-mingling with other schools and or parents, etc. underneath tents and all persons are to practice social distancing. Schools will be required to wipe down any common touch surfaces regularly and will be required to provide all students with hand sanisters and ball wipes. If you are found to not have these products under your tent you will be asked to rectify this immediately.

School Coordinators will be responsible of ensuring the COVID safe requirements are met and if they are found to be in breach, the School may be asked to leave the venue.

The QAS will work under the 2m2 rule for all tents, a sign indicating the maximum number of people allowed under each tent at any given time will be in position and must be adhered to.

Schools **MUST** ensure all tents are left clean at the end of each day, any rubbish left in the tent area may incur a cleaning fine.

### **ACCESS TO WATER**

Due to COVID Restrictions we request each School ensures appropriate water allocations are brought to the venue for their players. Teams are not allowed to bring communal water containers.

No players are to share drink bottles, all participants MUST bring their own water bottle and enough additional water for the day. Water will be available to be purchased from the Vendor City and the BMTA canteen.

### **POST-GAME**

Teams must leave the field once their game is completed and head back to their tent in between games. Balls should be sanitised post games, it is the Schools responsibility to bring hand sanitiser and hand wipes to the venue, however there will be additional items for purchase at the venue. Once your team has completed their games for the day, please leave the venue immediately.

### **SANITISATION**

All players, referees, coaches and managers must sanitise when they enter the venue, prior and post games and whilst eating. Hand Sanitiser stations will be positioned around the venue however we encourage schools to bring their own as well.

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

All attendees are to practice social distancing at all times throughout the event.

### TIME AT THE VENUE

Do not stay longer at the venue than what you are required. The QAS encourages all teams to exit the venue as soon as their last game has been played and to only arrive prior at the venue with enough time to warm up.

### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Regular announcements will be made throughout the day reminding all patrons to practice social distancing, maintain good hygiene and abide by COVID safe practices.

### **SIGNAGE**

Signs will be positioned around the venue reminding all patrons to practice social distancing as well as personal hygiene requirements.

### **TOILETS**

Toilets will be available at the BMTA club house, these toilets will only be accessible from the back of the clubhouse.

Additional toilets have been brought in which will be positioned near the Cricket Club house and the Vendor City. These will be cleaned regularly throughout the day.


### **PRESENTATIONS**

All presentations will occur directly after the final match, this is to relieve large crowds and teams staying at the venue for additional time.

### **EVENT STAFF**

There will be QTF Staff positioned around the venue managing the COVID Safe Requirements and ensuring no congregating can occur. All directions from QTF staff MUST be adhered to and any school found to be in breach of these directions can be asked to leave the venue.


### COVID DISCIPLINARY ESCALATION PROCESS FOR ATTENDEES



### GENERAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

### **VENUE LOCATION**

Whites Hill, Boundary Road, Camp Hill.



### **MEDICAL**

Medical staff will be available on site to manage injuries that occur whilst on the field, there will be two medical locations, these are visible on the Event site map. Due to COVID Restrictions maximum numbers will be indicated on the tents and protocols will apply.

Sports Trainers and an EMT will be onsite for the entirety of the event. If an ambulance is required on site this will be organised by the Medical team in association with the QAS event team.

### Concussion:

It is a reminder that QTF and QAS approved concussion in Sport Policy aligns with the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) and Australian Medical Association (AMA) joint Position Statement on Concussion in Sport. Please ensure all medical staff make the selves familiar with the <a href="https://www.concussioninsport.gov.au">www.concussioninsport.gov.au</a> website. Sports Concussion Assessment Tool (SCAT5) and other helpful information is contained at the back of this pack. If in doubt, please flag down a QAS event staff who will be able to contact our trained event medical team.

### SCHOOL CONTACT COMMUNICATION

School Contacts are encouraged to contact Peter Bell if they have any issues, problems or questions. A School Contact may be called at any time during the event if required for urgent and or matters that affect their school.

### **TOURNAMENT CHECK IN**

Due to the impact of gatherings in a COVID world we would like schools to stagger their submissions of the Registration Form (hard copy) required before your first game.

To assist with this, a box/tray will be placed on the verandah of the clubhouse and clearly labelled REGISTRATION FORMS. *You will still be able to access admin staff at the counter* but if there is a queue (or more than 5 or six persons in the counter area), schools are asked to place their forms into the box to avoid this issue. Note – that students should not be in the admin area and forms should be submitted by a teacher.

**IMPORTANT** – Registration Forms are critical to our organisation and must be handed in as soon as possible to avoid losing points.

### **LIVESTREAM**

Field 1 games will be livestreamed on Saturday & Sunday of the event and will be available on the QTF YouTube and Facebook. More details regarding this will be made available via the QTF Facebook page and the QAS Website - <a href="https://gldallschools.com.au/watch/">https://gldallschools.com.au/watch/</a>.

All persons accept that, by participating in this event, they may be photographed/filmed and that these images may be used by QAS and QTF and our partner (Brisbane City Council) for promotion of the sport and/or event.

QAS & QTF will not pass any image(s) onto a third party (outside of our event funding partner) unless prior approval is sought. All Schools are required to provide a list to Tournament Control prior to competition outlining any individuals who do not consent to begin filmed/photographed at the event.

### **EVENT EMERGENCY PROCEDURE**

**Evacuation Procedure** 

If a decision is made to evacuate the following process will be undertaken:

- QAS & QTF Event Staff will ensure general exits are open with instructions communicated.
- Event Staff will notify nearby patrons where possible and instruct them to the nearest safe emergency assembly area.
- Event Patrons will then be notified via the stadium loudspeaker system with the following where relevant:

"Ladies and Gentlemen, the management have requested that although you are in immediate danger, for your safety we have to stop the games temporality and evacuate the venue. Please assist by remaining clam and move in the direction indicated by the nearest event staff. "

Patrons will be asked to remain in the designated emergency assembly area, if it is safe to do so, until the threat has been eliminated.

There is one emergency assembly point which is positioned between the BMTA club house and the Cricket fields. These emergency assembly areas are indicated on the event map.

### **FOOD HANDLING**

Entities are reminded that in 2020 due to COVID shared food, platters/cocktail style food and self-sever buffets are not to be brought into the venue and no food is to be prepared on site. Please do not share food or water containers at this year QLD All Schools.

### TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Traffic Management will be arranged for the event. This will help allocate parking locations and traffic flow, please listen to the instructions from the Traffic Marshals.

### Minibus Parking

Mini Bus parking will be available near field 1 and 2 this will once again be allocated on a first in first served basis.

### Drop off Zone

Schools and parents can drop off participants at the drop off zone which is positioned near field 3.

### Large Bus parking

Large Buses must park within the car park the bottom of the ring road near field 18, once they have dropped participants off at the drop off location.

### Other Parking

All other parking options can be found on the parking map. Note no spectators are to park and enter the venue, we understand parents/ guardians will be required to complete drop offs, however spectators will be asked to leave the venue by Event Staff if they are found to be congregating in the area.

### **SECURITY**

There will be overnight security for the duration of the event. Although there is security present, QTF recommends that all valuables are not left at the fields overnight. There have also been issues during the day with bags and uniforms going missing and we ask for all participants and spectators to be vigilant with their belongings.

### **WARMING UP**

All teams must adhere to the 2m2 spacing whilst warming up prior to games. Warm up areas can be found on the event site map, if your team is found to be in breach of the COVID Requirements they will be asked to move on by event staff.

### **FOOD VENDORS/CANTEENS**

The QAS would prefer EFTPOS to be used over cash, however both will be available.

The BMTA Canteen and Vendor City will be operational during the event. These will be takeaway only; participants must purchase food and head back to the school tent to eat.

The BMTA clubhouse will have defined entry and exit points to manage pedestrian flow. In addition, toilets will only be accessible from the back of the clubhouse.

### **WEATHER**

QAS reserves the right to organise affected games in whatever format which will assist the games to occur in as equal conditions as possible. QAS will use the Extreme Weather Guidelines in the case of Hot Weather, Wet Weather and Storms.

### \*\*Note - Determining the best Seconds and Thirds

The overall positioning of teams and the determining of the Pool winner at the end of the round robin for Progression (to the Finals Series or the Final 16 and or quarter finals etc) is as per the *Conditions* of *Play - 12.4*.

In determining progression an issue arises when divisions have Pools with varying team numbers. (e.g. 6, 7 or 8 teams) Since games played varies across Pools, the number of games played shall be equalized for a fairer comparison. Pools of 8 teams shall have the game against the lowest ranked team at the end of the round robin removed from calculations of Differential and Percentages as per below. Pools of 6 teams shall have the game vs the lowest ranked team at the end of the round robin added to calculations (i.e. twice). A comparison across Pools will now follow the procedure below.

### Determining Finals Ranking Across All Pools (only applies to second or third ranked teams in a Pool)

Teams are compared & ranked using the following procedure:

- 1. Differential (for minus against)
- 2. Percentage (for divided by against x 100)
- 3. Drop off if all else equal
