TOURNAMENT DETAILS

The event begins at 7.30am Wednesday 6 October for all Junior teams (i.e. 13s and 15s divisions) Junior finals are Saturday 9 October. The Opens (18s) divisions begins Friday from 1pm and rounds continue Saturday with Finals on Sunday 10 October. Days are usually from 7.30am until 8.30pm.

Schools are required to commit to play at anytime although country schools may apply for dispensation according to their individual constraints.

However, at all times there is no guarantee of entry for any school who cannot satisfy the draw/event conditions.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Before entering make sure you are conversant with and accept the relevant conditions of entry and the Cancellation and withdrawals Policy.

NOMINATION PROCESS 2021

Nominations open Friday 29 January. You will need to complete the entry form and submit before COB Friday 12 February. Places are extremely sought after and it is usual to have many more nominations than the available places. As such schools will be afforded entry on a criteria based points system. Please read the relevant document (All Schools Nomination Process) for details.

Note - There have been some changes from previous years. You will be required to work out your points and submit the total. Audits shall take place where required. Once schools have been accepted, they will receive a Participation Advice which needs to completed accurately and without delay to secure your spot. Schools who do not make the cut will be placed on the reserve list and when withdrawals occur throughout the year, places will be offered. **Note** - In 2020 all reserve list schools were offered places in the event.

COST TO ENTER

The basic Entry fee is \$495 per team which includes both GST and an official All Schools match ball. The ball is new and especially designed for this event. It is also available for purchase from Inferno. The basic fee requires all teams to provide referees to avoid the surcharge as below. Payment for All Schools is strictly as per the conditions of entry. Please read these conditions before you enter. Entry is void until payment is received.

REFEREE SURCHARGE

- I referee or \$400
- 3 referees or \$800
- 2 referees or \$600

Note - referees are paid and must do a minimum of 7 games at the All Schools.
