UNIFORM POLICY

About this Policy

This policy covers the requirements of each participating school when competing/officiating at the All Schools event.

Background

Qld All Schools and Qld Touch Football have clear expectations with regards to both playing and referee uniforms worn by participants at the event. The organization strives to present a professionally organized event which attracts both government and corporate support. Therefore, in order to maintain high standards across all areas, it is expected that schools endeavour to meet the guidelines below. If there are issues with any please ensure you discuss with the Tournament Director before the event in order to achieve a favourable outcome for all.

Guidelines

Playing Uniform Standard

All participant Schools/Teams -

- 1. Must comply with the current TFA rules as applied to all their events. (This means, appropriately sized numbers with each player having their own identifiable number etc.)
- 2. Must have identical uniforms (including Mixed teams) and no mismatch of uniforms will be allowable.
- 3. Should be aware that no unauthorized use of logos including the TFA, QTF, and or QAS logos without written consent is permissible.
- 4. Must not use predominantly "pink" uniforms since this will clash with the official QAS referee uniform colour of pink & black.
- 5. May wear Singlets, tees or jerseys and or shorts, bike pants or similar. (see #2 above)
- 5. If unsure about your status please seek clarification to avoid issues at the event.

Referee Uniform Standard *

All participating officials -

- 1. Must wear the official QAS Referee pink & black shirt. (Where referee shortages become apparent, one off games may be completed in an alternative uniform provided permission is obtained from the Tournament Director)
- 2. Referees who have the official TFA referee shirt (also pink) may wear this uniform. No other older referee shirts are permissible.
- 3. Either of the TFA shorts or the QAS black shorts may be worn. Plain black shorts are preferable if no official short is available.

*Please note that the purchase of referee shirts will be the responsibility of individual referees including students. The shirt can be pre-ordered and or purchased in lieu of games completed at the QAS. We would encourage schools to purchase the shirts for their student referees beforehand and as part of their overall QAS budget. Referee shirts are available from the Inferno shop on line.
